What to Bring to Your Health Insurance Enrollment Appointment/Screening if You are losing Coverage

To get the most out of your appointment, please bring all of the following that apply to you, and to any and all members of your household:

- 2023 Household income, including job-based or self-employment income, severance, income raises that go retroactive, vacation pay
- Social Security numbers just the numbers, not the cards
- Copies of Legal Resident documents
- W-2 forms, work pay stubs (the two most recent, from all jobs), and/or a tax return from the previous year
- COBRA rates

Also bring any of these if they apply to you, or to any member of your household:

- A Social Security income statement
- An unemployment letter
- The amount of **interest** being paid on student loans
- Profits from stocks or real estate sales
- Early withdrawals from retirement or 401K funds
- Winnings from the lottery, and/or from any casino, either domestic or abroad
- Net Rental Income

During your appointment, an online <u>Health Insurance</u> <u>Marketplace</u> account may be created for you. As part of that process, you'll be asked to log in to your email account, so you'll need to know both **your username and password**. If you don't have an email account, one can be created for you.
